

2021 Year End PBC Membership Report

The 2021 calendar year has been a busy one from the Registration side of PBC. With Covid restrictions lifting ever so gradually and incrementally, most of our clubs began some sort of operation for the 2021 season. This was also the year when the PCNS National Registration system was introduced for the use of our organization and our provincial clubs.

Over the course of the year, we processed 10700 PBC registrations, including 9700 online through the PCNS. This total does not include the hundreds of you who joined a second club during the year and were not charged PBC dues for those secondary registrations. We also had 2000 Active members re-register during the last 3 months of the year and extended their membership to the end of 2022.

This left PBC at year's end with 8688 active members in the province, about 32% of all active members in PCO across the country. This total is over 2000 higher than our membership at the end of 2020.

Over the course of the year 60 clubs were set up to use the PCNS system for their local registration, and many of them are also using the system for Event Invitations and Management as well as other administrative features introduced during the year. The PCNS is continuing to evolve and expand its usability and versatility for our clubs, and we look forward to providing you with more opportunities to find places and events to enjoy our great game in the future.
