Tournament Information:

- This is a non-sanctioned tournament.
- All games in round robin play are first team to 11 points, no overtime.
- Tournament results will be based on Wins, Points and Spread, and if still tied, a coin toss to determine who moves on.
- Crossover games and Finals are up to 11 points but must win by 2 points.
- Food will be available throughout the day for participants (Fruit, veggies, sandwiches, meat & cheese platter, coffee, and pastries)
- Players may play up in an event rated higher than their playing level, but they may not play down at a level lower than their rating.
- Each player must register, pay the registration fee, and pay the fee for each event entered.
- Medals will be awarded to winning teams of each ranking.
- Warmup will commence at 8:00AM for the morning division and 12:30PM for afternoon division (see Divisions & Format section).
- On the day of your event(s), please check in with the event staff.
- All scores for games will be kept by the players of the tournament (No referees). All scores will be kept on a Pickleball BC scoresheet.
- Please report your scores to event staff after the completion of each game.
